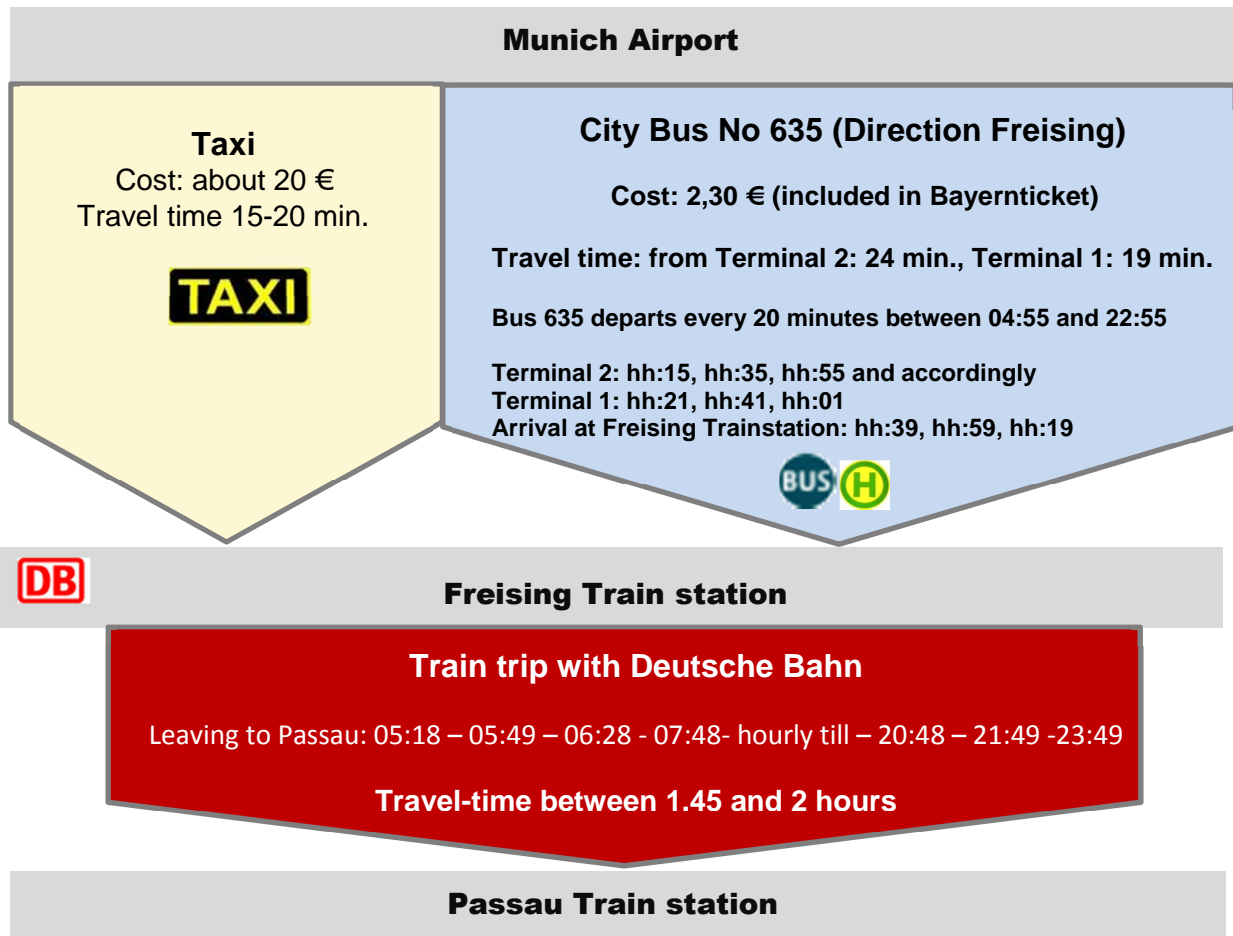


Travelling from Munich to Passau by means of public transport:



Best option for your train-ticket	
<p>For travelling between Munich Airport and Passau you can use the Bayern-Ticket which is valid for the bus (635) and for the trains (RE, S1). The Bayern-Ticket is cheaper if purchased at the ticket-machine, which can be found in the central part of the Airport. It can also be purchased at Freising Trainstation. Please note: Bayern-Ticket is valid for all local trains (Interregio-Express, Regional-Express, Regionalbahn, S-Bahn) and public urban transport in all Bavarian cities. It is neither valid for IC/ICE trains nor for any trains outside of Bavaria. Please add an additional EUR 2.00 to the relevant fare if you purchase your ticket at the Travel Centre.
