## **UNIVERSITY POLITICS**

This year's university elections will be held on 06.07.2022. On that day, you can cast your vote from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. in the Innsteg Auditorium (ISA, Innstrasse 23). If you can't vote in person or the date is not convenient for you, then you can also request a <u>postal ballot</u> until the 29th of June, which you need to collect until that day from the Elections Office in the Administration building, room VW 305. **Every vote counts!** Because a higher voter turnout leads to a better legitimacy of all elected representatives and thus allows us to represent the interests of the students as well and as broadly as possible. There, we will also introduce our candidates in more detail, so that you can get a better idea of who you are voting for.
